The Central Ontario Railway, a world in miniature, depicts Canadian railroading in the late 1950's during the transition from steam to diesel locomotives. It is an "O" Scale (1/4"= 1 ft.) model railroad located in a 103' by 32' room with trains traveling over 5,000 feet of track, connecting two major cities, each with full yard and engine facilities. Canadian National and Canadian Pacific trains appear regularly on the Central Ontario Railway.
