USEFUL INFORMATION

STATION TICKET OFFICES are open for the sale of tickets thirty minutes before departure of trains and passengers are requested to purchase tickets before entering cars.

ROUND TRIP TICKETS, first class, valid one month from date of issue, are for sale at reduced fares between stations on the Central Ontario Railway. They are not transferable, and are not good to stop over at any intermediate station unless so stated on ticket.

MILEAGE TICKETS, at low rate, can be purchased at all stations. Commercial Travellers' tickets on sale and Travellers' samples checked through from principal stations on this line to all points on the Grand Trunk and Canadian Pacific Railways.

COUPON TICKETS to all points on the Continent can be procured from principal Central Ontario Railway agents.

CHILDREN under five years of age, when accompanied, will be carried free; children between five and twelve years will be carried at half fare. All twelve years and over must pay adult fare.

LOST TICKETS. Railway companies are not responsible for lost tickets. All possible precaution should be taken to prevent their loss. Upon purchasing tickets passengers should make a memorandum of the "Destination," "By what Railway issued," "Form Number," "Consecutive Number," "Place and date of Sale," also of the consecutive numbers of their baggage checks. This will aid in their recovery if lost or stolen.

PERSONAL BAGGAGE consisting of wearing apparel to the extent of 150 lbs. in weight will be checked on each adult passage ticket and 75 lbs. on each child's half ticket. Personal baggage exceeding these free allowances will be charged for. No piece of baggage weighing more than 250 lbs. will be checked. All baggage should be addressed.

Passengers paying for excess baggage will receive an excess baggage check which must be delivered to agent when baggage is claimed.

It is unlawful to carry dangerous articles such as matches, gunpowder, etc., in baggage.

BAGGAGE FOR FLAG STATIONS or stations where agents are not on duty must be claimed at baggage car door immediately on arrival, otherwise it will be carried to next station where agent is on duty and held for further orders.

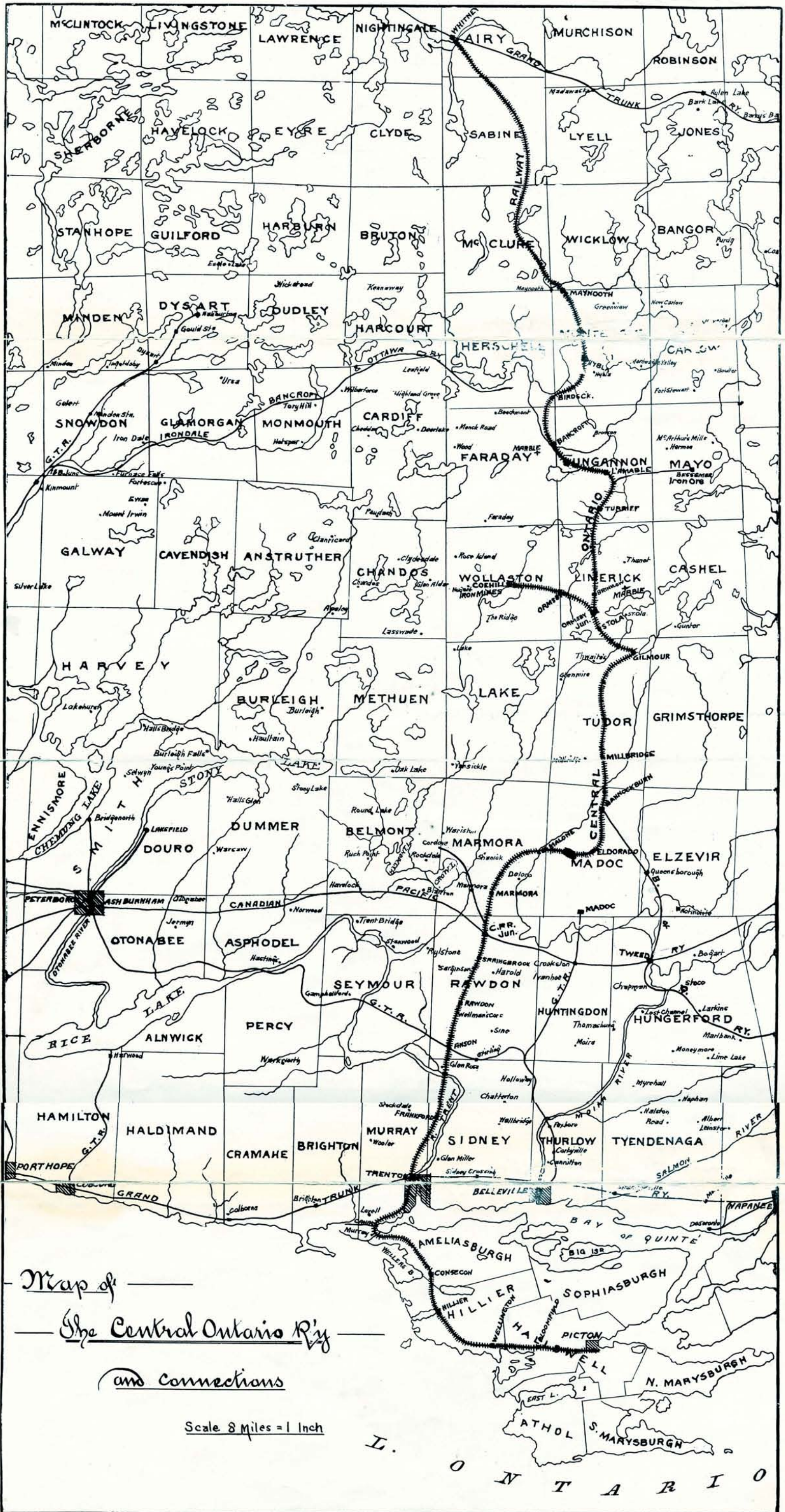
FARES CANNOT BE ADJUSTED BY CONDUCTORS. In the event of a disagreement with a Conductor relative to tickets required, privileges allowed, etc., passengers should pay the Conductor, take his receipt and refer the case to the General Manager for adjustment. The Conductor is governed by rules he cannot change.
